

Slitting/Cutting Vinyl to Size

A short look at the process.



Cutting down vinyl rolls to size.....yes it can be done! With good results. With the following pics it's self explanatory...here I cut down a 54" x 10 Yard roll of LG 3910. The saw - cheapo Sears Craftsman 7 1/4 well over 10 years old. The blade is similar to this [one](#). I also have a 12" out on loan right now(where is my saw BOB?)...I use for bigger rolls.

I measure down to size, I mark it all the way around. I like to wrap it tight with application tape.

It's real important to support the other end of the roll, wood block will suffice.

No real trick other then going real slow. Clean it up. Done. As you can see in the last pic, the blade has been well used...

*** Quick Note** - If your cutting vinyl for use in Summa's Thermal Printers (DC3 & DC4) be sure to cut the correct side the one to far right of the print head
